78% patients are females under 50

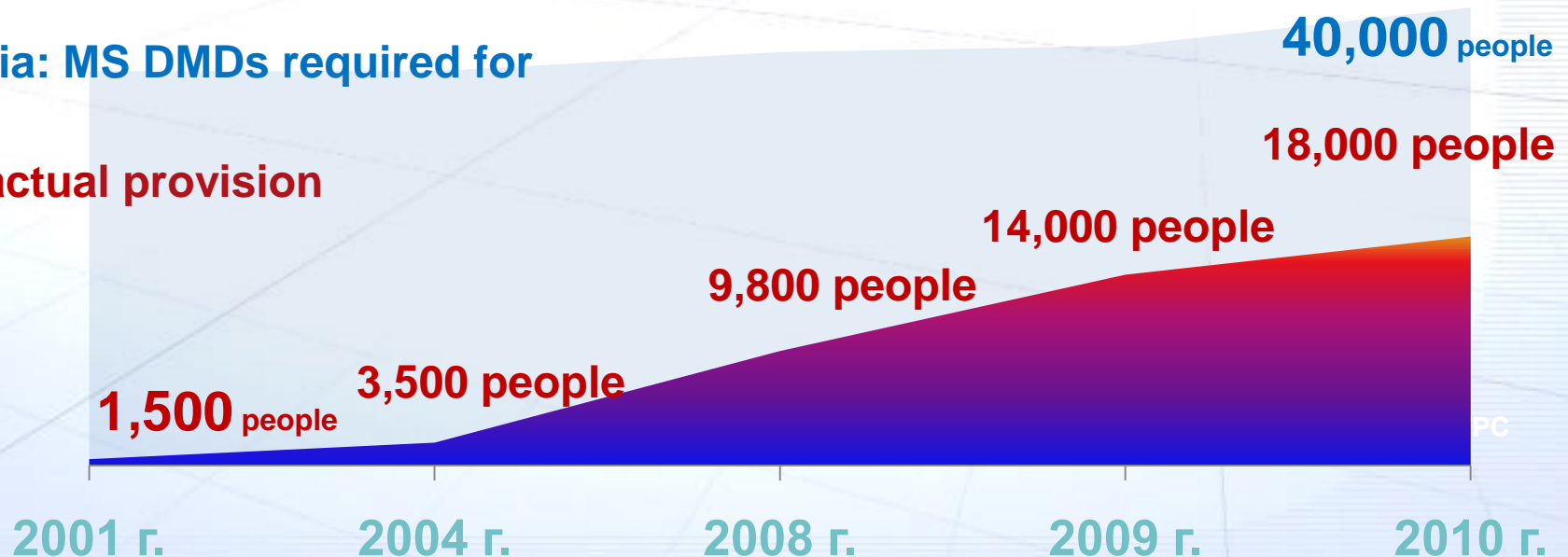

To establish conditions to improve the quality of life of Russian people affected by multiple sclerosis.

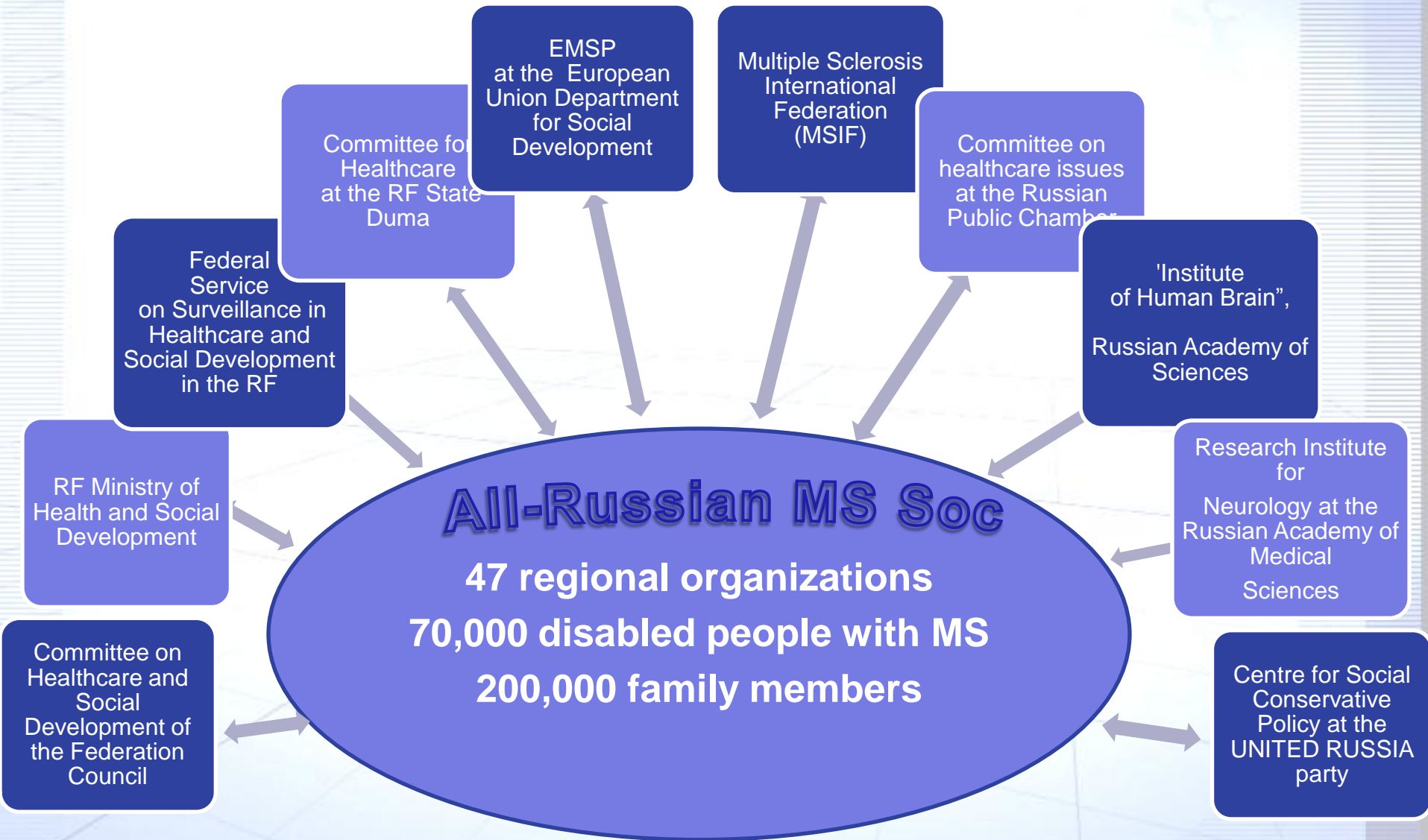
Vision

Courses in projects

1. Co-management of people affected by multiple sclerosis. Involvement of those in social and vocational activities. Management of leisure activities, mutual assistance, employment, making communicative environment, support for the families of people with MS.
2. Assistance in improving the quality of medical and social support.
3. Ensuring advocacy activities for people with MS through legislation development and taking measures to control the execution of it.
4. Contribution to training and retraining of staff on MS issues.
5. Creation of a positive attitude among general public, raising MS awareness and informing about ways to cope with the problem.
6. Activation and consolidation of efforts of social partners in fighting MS.
7. Development in the Third Sector and social participation. Distribution of effective models for NGO activities.

In all, there are over 40 grant projects totaling more than 37 million rubles (1 million euro)
